Paper Submission Guidelines

Full Papers: Present completed research findings related to leadership, governance, or accountability in higher education. Full papers should be up to 8 pages (5,000 words) and include in-depth analysis, case studies, or empirical data.

Short Papers: Intended for work-in-progress studies or recent developments. They should not exceed 4 pages (2,500 words) and focus on early-stage research, conceptual ideas, or theoretical frameworks.

Reflection Papers: Review recent research or case studies on leadership and governance issues, suggest new perspectives, or discuss challenges. Reflection papers should not exceed 4 pages (2,500 words).

Page Setup: Margins: 1 inch (2.54 cm) on all sides, Font Size and Type: 11pt Arial Narrow, Line Spacing: Single space, Alignment: Justified, Orientation: Portrait, Page Size: A4

Preparation of Text: Title: 14pt, bold, and centered; include name, surname, academic title, affiliation, and e-mail, Abstract: 150-250 words in 10pt Arial Narrow italic; include up to 5 bold keywords; leave one empty line between the abstract and main text.

Subdivision of the Article: Word Count: 2,000-5,000 words, Numbering: Each title and subtitle section should be numbered (abstract not included in numbering), Formatting: 12pt font, justified; leave one empty line between titles and main text. Include pictures within the text.

References: Follow APA style. List only in-text citations in the References section. For example: Kidder, T. (1981). The soul of a new machine. Boston, MA: Little, Brown & Company.

Abstract Review Criteria: Research Problem/Purpose: Summarize purpose and rationale (1-2 sentences), Literature Review: Identify consulted literature and summarize key points (1-2 sentences), Methodology: Describe study type, participants, location, data collection, and analysis techniques, Results and Conclusions: Summarize research answers, implications, limitations, and suggested future research (1 sentence each), Practical Implication: State implications for research, practice, and/or society (1 sentence), Originality: Highlight new and significant information (1 sentence), Paper Type: Research, Keywords: Up to 5 words

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
